TRAVIS AIR MUSEUM is dedicated to aviation history and the heritage of Travis Air Force Base and its units. Established in 1982, the Museum performs a variety of educational services and serves as a meeting place and forum for aviation-oriented individuals and organizations.



INDOOR EXHIBITS

showcase Jimmy Doolittle and the Tokyo Raiders, the 15th AF in WWII, the Tuskegee Airmen, the WASPS, the Consairways story, the Berlin Airlift, and the history of Travis AFB.

Other exhibits include a space capsule for children, air force uniforms, a "fat boy" atomic bomb, the nose of a WWII glider, WWII aircraft recognition models, a link trainer, aircraft engines, and the cockpits of a T-28, a T-37, and a F-100.
